Exciting news for Coastal Academy – North Charleston families! We're thrilled to announce our participation in the ABC Child Care Program, effective January 2024. This program, run by the South Carolina Department of Social Services (DSS), assists eligible families with affording quality childcare for their children.

Who qualifies for the ABC Child Care Program at Coastal Academy?

Program Criteria (as of January 2024):

- Have a child or children between birth and 12 years of age.
- Work at least 15 hours per week, attend school, or be engaged in a training program.
- Maintain a gross income at or below 85% of the state median income level. For a family of four, this threshold would be up to \$76,272 annually.

How does the program work?

The ABC program helps cover a portion of your child care costs for children up to 12 years old. The amount of financial assistance depends on your child's age, the needed childcare hours, and the chosen care provider. If there are any remaining costs, you may be responsible for a co-payment based on your family's income and size.

- Extracurricular Activities: From time to time we may offer optional enrichment programs such as music lessons, sports, or field trips, which may incur additional charges.
- Late Pick-Up Fees: Most providers charge fees to late pickup due to staff overtime and encourage smooth scheduling.
